**Bible study groups begin at 9:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below).** You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

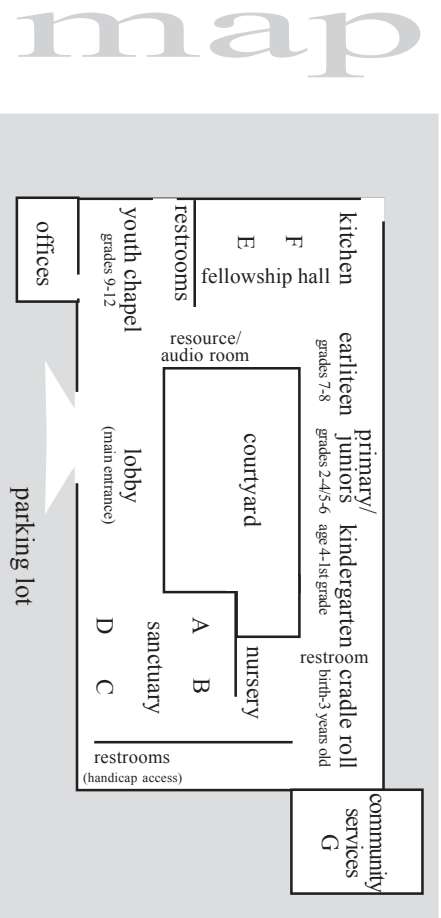

### VEGETARIAN LIFESTYLE

Can vegetarian eating supply your body with enough nutrients? The answer is yes. Both vegetarian and non vegetarian eating styles can be healthful. The bottom line depends on your food choices over time. Studies show a positive link between vegetarian eating and health. In general, heart disease, high blood pressure, adult-onset diabetes, obesity and some forms of cancer tend to develop less often among vegetarians than non vegetarians.
