1. The Sabbath morning breakfasts continue to be served from 8-9 o'clock and could use more volunteers. Contact Steve Holms to be put on the schedule or to contribute toward the food.
2. We thank God for the success realized by participants in 12-step programs worldwide and are thankful that we are able to have these meetings each Sabbath morning between 9 and 10:15 in the Community Services waiting room.



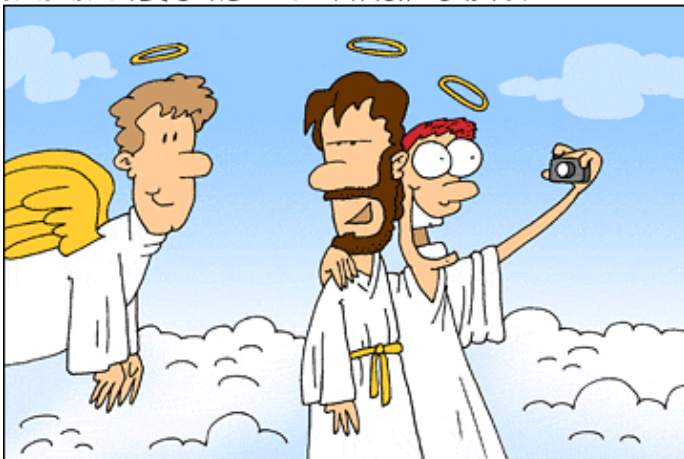
