Bible study groups begin at 9:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

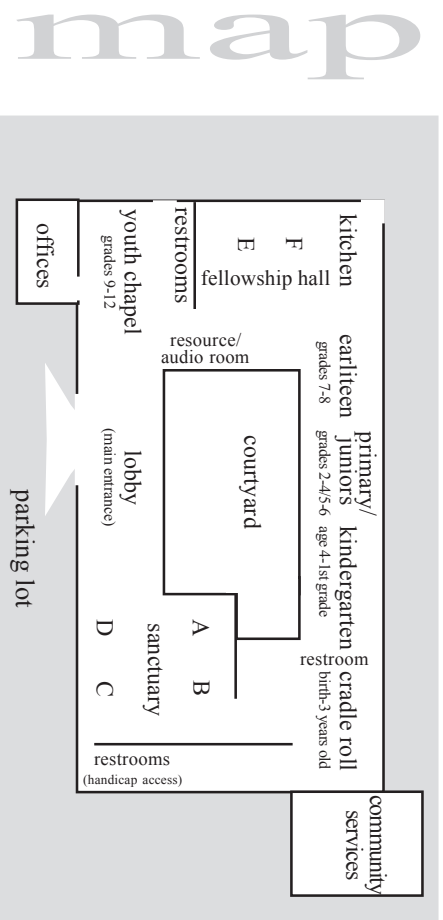

NATIONAL CHOLESTEROL AWARENESS MONTH Cholesterol is a waxy, fat-like substance used to form the inner lining of cell membranes. It plays a role in producing vitamin D and some hormones. Cholesterol can be divided into two categories – HDL (high density lipoprotein) and LDL (low density lipoprotein) cholesterol. HDL cholesterol is the "good" cholesterol, which means you want HIGH levels of those lipoproteins in your blood. While, LDL cholesterol levels you want to keep LOW because they can cause plaque to build up in the arteries.
