Bible study groups begin at 9:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

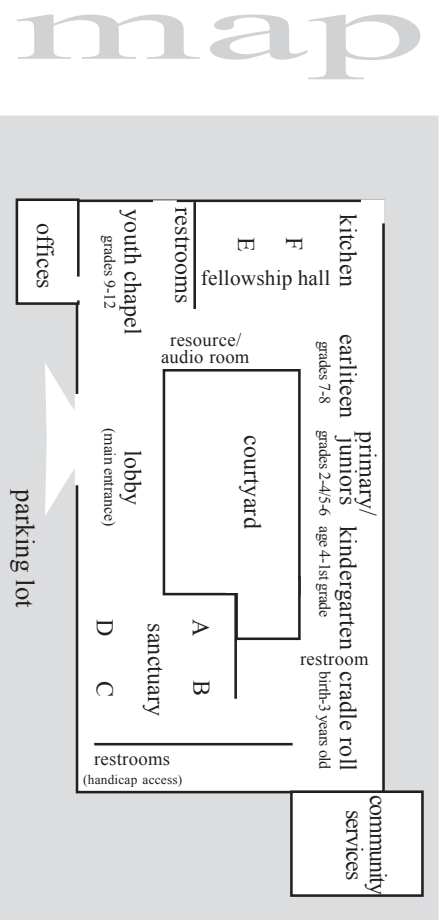

Trans fats and Saturated Fats contain the highest concentration of LDL cholesterol and therefore should be avoided or used sparingly. Monounsaturated and polyunsaturated fats – the fats found in olive oil, peanut oil, and vegetable oil – can raise HDL cholesterol levels in the blood, and decrease the risk of heart disease.
