Bible study groups begin at 9:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

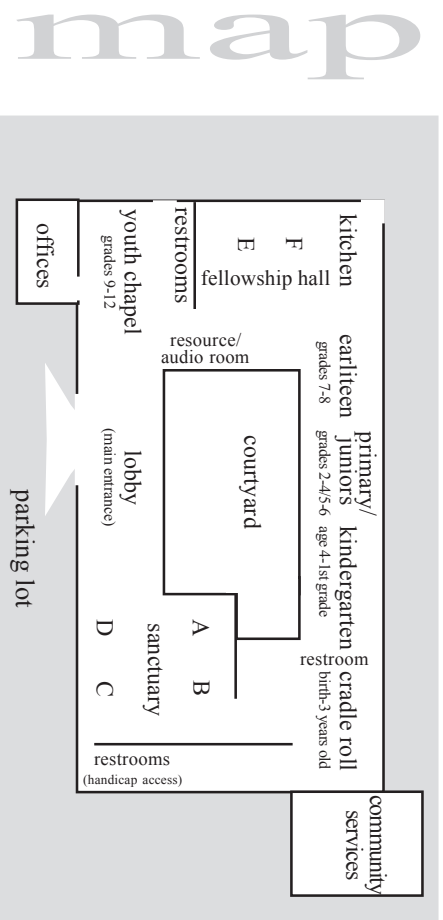
