Bible study groups begin at 11:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

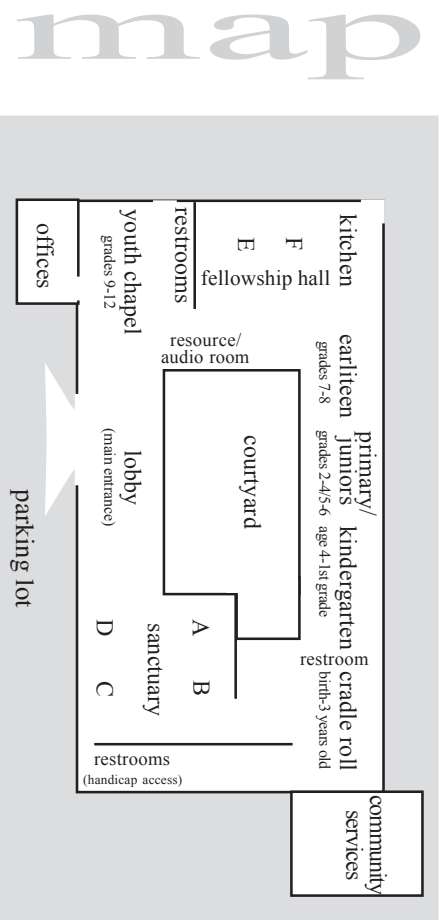

- **Adult Quarterly:** *The Fruit of the Spirit*—takes a look at Galatians 5:22, 23 not to focus on how we can become more patient or more loving or more gentle or more faithful but on how we can let the Holy Spirit make us more like Jesus, who is patience, love, gentleness, and faithfulness personified. - **Second Look:** This group takes a deeper look at the sermon topic presented today. (B: *Led by Pastor Dan/Dave in the left front of the Sanctuary*)
- **Bible Basics:** This small group takes a look at the basics of Christian Beliefs. (D: *Led by Jim Fraizer in the right rear of the Sanctuary*)
- **Living & Learning Verse by Verse:** Come join us for a lively discussion as we study the book of Matthew. (E: *Led Jim Brewster in Fellowship Room #1*)
