**Bible study groups begin at 11:30am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below).** You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).

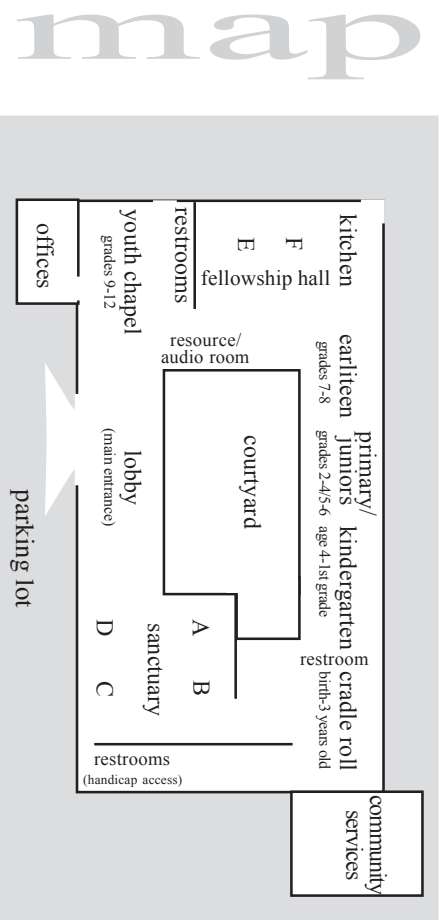

- **Second Look:** This group takes a deeper look at the sermon topic presented today. (B: *Led by Pastor Dan/Dave in the left front of the Sanctuary*)
- **Bible Basics:** This small group takes a look at the basics of Christian Beliefs. (D: *Led by Jim Fraizer in the right rear of the Sanctuary*)
- **Living & Learning Verse by Verse:** Come join us for a lively discussion as we study the book of Matthew. (E: *Led Jim Brewster in Fellowship Room #1*)
