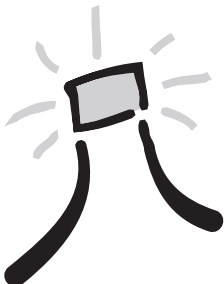

Who is the Church Finance Committee and what do they do?

Over the next several months, there will be a series of articles published in the church newsletter as well as bulletin inserts that will answer questions that you may have in regard to how we manage our church's finances.

This first article will discuss the members of the finance committee, how they are selected, and the primary responsibilities and roles of the committee.

Future articles will cover such topics as the Church Family Budget, Pine Hills Adventist Academy subsidy, our student assistance program and local conference and world church special purpose offerings among other topics.

We will also discuss how to complete your Tithe and Offering envelope to insure that your offerings are used as you intend and how to designate funds to be used for specific purposes.

Who are the members of the church finance committee and how are they selected?

The 2009 – 2010 Church Finance Committee membership is Jim Brewster, Chair, Don Dyer, Treasurer, Dick McDaniel, Kendall Porco, Rodney Wehtje, Mike Sutter, Dan Appel, and Dave Carreon. Membership on the committee is for a one year term. Members are selected each year by the Nominating Committee and approved by the general church membership.

How often does the church finance committee meet?

The committee normally meets once each month just prior to the monthly board meeting. Occasionally there will be special meetings to deal with time sensitive issues.

What are the main responsibilities of the church finance committee?

Other major responsibilities of the committee include the review of requests for student assistance and requests for use of the benevolent fund.

The finance committee reviews the most recent financial statement at each meeting, monitors giving and expenditure of funds, and provides recommendations to the church board in regard to the purchase of equipment and major repairs.

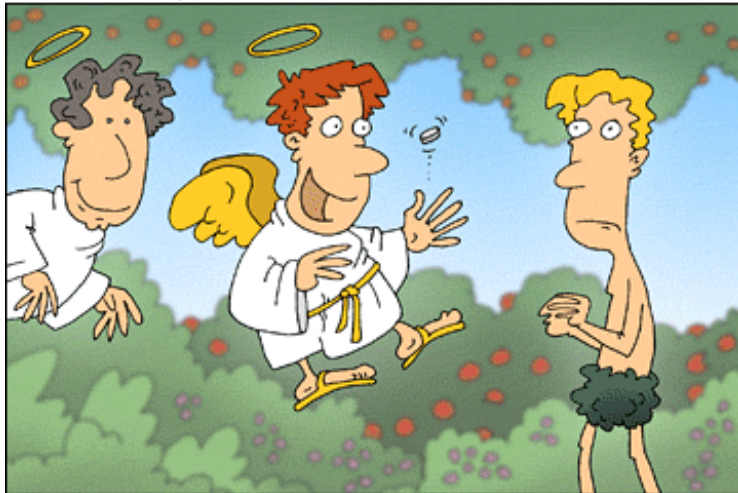
