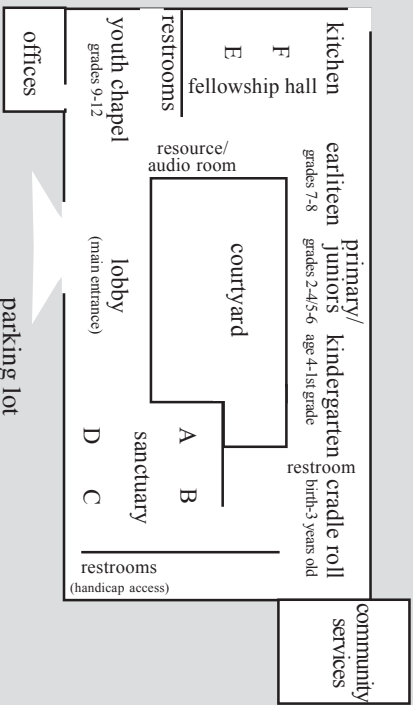
An offering is taken during our study time and supports various mission projects as well as providing study materials for all age groups on Sabbath mornings.
