





Saturday, May 3, Session 4 – **The Dawn of a New Day**

- ❖ When Jesus said to the fellow prisoner on the cross “You will be with me in Paradise.” He meant in the Garden of Eden not heaven. The Dawn of a new day was his death on the cross.
- ❖ Jesus became the redeemer of the Earth at His resurrection. The Kingdom of heaven has arrived on Earth in the person of a resurrected Jesus.
- ❖ Jesus brought a non violent human community to Earth.
- ❖ If you want to follow Jesus, deny yourself and take up the cross.
- ❖ Jesus didn’t teach passive resistance He taught non violent direct action.
- ❖ Christianity will be the last kingdom standing.
- ❖ The early Christians would not say Jesus died on the cross so that they didn’t have to, they would say Jesus died to heal the Word down here on Earth.
- ❖ Jesus didn’t die so we could get to heaven, He died to bring heaven to Earth so Earth could be recreated and made new.
- ❖ The story of Jesus and His resurrection marks the end of the Sacrificial System that demanded the death of those who are innocent. It puts on display that the presence of God is not found within the most exclusive holy places found within political systems relying on violence, religion systems based on fear or economic systems driven by greed. He is found in Christ on the Cross.

Jan's Healthy Recipes

Herb Montgomery Seminar

Blueberry Yogurt Pie

Ingredients

- **For the Crust**
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 egg
- 1 cup flour (plus more to dust)
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- Salt to taste

- **For the Filling**
- 2 eggs
- 3 tablespoons sugar
- 1 cup vanilla yogurt
- Juice and zest of 1 lemon
- 1 pint fresh blueberries

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350°F.

In a stand mixer with the paddle attachment, cream the butter and sugar. Add the egg and beat until combined. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, and salt. Add to the creamed mixture and beat until a dough is formed. Form into a ball and chill for 30 minutes.

On a floured work surface, roll the ball of dough out larger than your tart shell, and about 1/2-inch thick.

Lightly grease and flour the tart shell, and then roll the dough over the shell and with floured fingers, press into the edges. Use flour as needed to prevent dough from sticking. Chill the crust for 15 minutes while you prepare the filling.

Blueberry Yogurt Pie Recipe Cont.

In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs, sugar, vanilla yogurt, lemon juice and zest until completely smooth, trying to avoid any bubbles. Pour the blueberries into the prepared tart shell.

Pour the filling into the tart shell and bake for 45 to 50 minutes, until the custard is just set and the crust is golden brown. Allow to cool to room temperature. Serve room temperature or very lightly chilled.

Helpful Tips: Make sure your knuckles have flour on them, to pinch the pie crust into the pan. Let the dough chill in the refrigerator, but do not pre-bake the crust.
