STUDYING TOGETHER: SABBATH

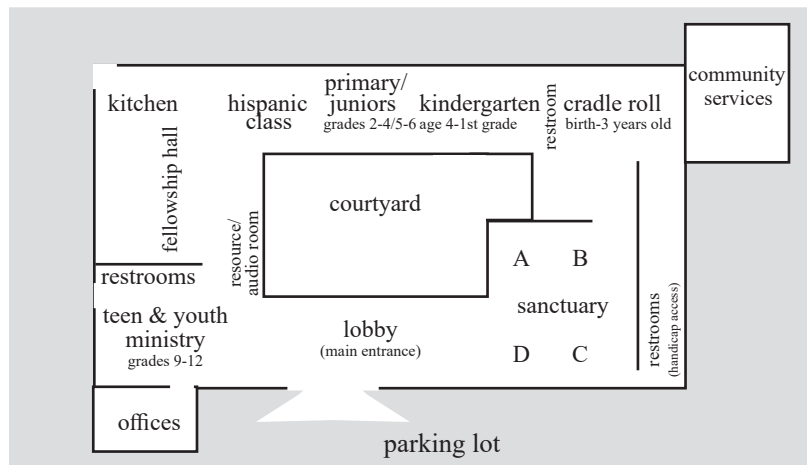
Bible study groups begin at 10:00am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below).

STUDY GROUP LOCATIONS

- **A Conversation About the Scriptures:** Join us for Fellowship and a lively discussion of The Life and Teachings of Jesus. 2,000 years ago, four men wrote accounts of the life of Jesus. Each shared from their unique perspective the story of Jesus life, death, and teachings. The class will look at the major events of Jesus life and his major teachings as revealed in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. *Fellowship Hall-rooms 1 & 2 - Team led by Jim Brewster/Jeff Pierson/Brian Toppel*
- **Adult Quarterly - Matthew:** An inspired version of Jesus' story is given in the Gospel of Matthew, our topic for this quarter. Matthew, a Jewish believer in Jesus and one of the original disciples of Jesus, recounts the story of Jesus from his own Spirit-inspired perspective. Though in common with Mark, Luke and John, Matthew's theme is the incarnation, life, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus. *Front right of Sanctuary - Teacher: Mike Wood*
- **Just What is a Seventh-day Adventist?** You may be curious if you've never heard, or you may be questioning some of what you have heard or were taught - either way, this class is for you. Come join a lively discussion of important issues. *Front left of Sanctuary - Teacher: Virgil Starr*
