Bible study groups begin at 10:00am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups studying a wide variety of topics.



STUDY GROUP LOCATIONS

- **A Conversation About the Scriptures:** Join us for Fellowship and a lively discussion of The Life and Teachings of Jesus. 2,000 years ago, four men wrote accounts of the life of Jesus. Each shared from their unique perspective the story of Jesus life, death, and teachings.
