Jan's Healthy Recipes

Hazelnut Chocolate Chip Pizzelle

From Taste of Home Cooking, Bars & More

Do you know what a Pizzelle is? I didn't. Well, read and learn.

Ingredients:

- ◆ 4 eggs
- ◆ 1 cup sugar, or sugar substitute
- ◆ 3/4 cup butter, melted
- ◆ 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ◆ 1/2 cup finely chopped hazelnuts, toasted
- ◆ 1/2 cup miniature semisweet chocolate chips

Directions:

1. In a large bowl beat the eggs, sugar, and butter until smooth. Gradually add the flour and mix well. Fold in hazelnuts and chocolate chips.
2. Bake in a preheated Pizzelle Iron according to manufacturer's directions until golden brown. Remove to cooling rack. Store in an airtight container.
3. Makes 3 dozen, Prep time 15 minutes, Baking time 5 minutes.

New Showers for Community Services

Auburn Seventh-day Adventist Church's Community Services has upgraded to a new shower/restroom trailer to better serve the Auburn homeless population. Each Monday 9AM to 12 Noon, ACS volunteers provide warm showers, clean clothes, a hot lunch, snack bag, and other needed items to those in need on site.

The new 4-unit shower / restroom trailer replaces an old aging one that had been experiencing increasing breakdowns and leaks. Elk Creek Trailers manufactured the new trailer at a reduced fee since it's use is for charitable purposes.

The brand new shower / restroom trailer was made possible by several generous donations and grants totaling \$85,220 from: SDA Church North American Division (\$35,000), Sutter Health (\$25,000), United Auburn Indian Community (\$10,000), Northern California SDA Conference (\$2,000), Auburn SDA Church (\$1,000), and various donations from private donors.

The new custom trailer was delivered on December 8, 2023 and, on the same day, Auburn Crane "flew" the old trailer out and the new trailer into place for a greatly reduced charge. The old trailer was moved, free of charge, by Dave Hull to the Shared Abundance Organic Farm in Auburn, saving ACS the cost of disposing it. The new shower restroom trailer started serving the homeless community on January 1, 2024.

An awning has been ordered and will be added to the trailer once the rail and mounting materials arrive. The new shower / restroom trailer's dedication ceremony is scheduled for February 3, 2024 at 12:30 PM. Derrick Lea and Pastor James Lim (ACS Directors for the North American Division and Northern California Conferences respectively) will be here for the dedication ceremony. Church and community members are invited to attend to check out the wonderful addition to this vital community ministry at ACS.
