Answers to the Hydration Face-Off Quiz

Which is better for hydration—Cantaloupe or Honeydew melon? (1)

Cantaloupe with 90.2% water inches out Honeydew with 89.8%.

Both boost hydration on a hot summer day. They also contain electrolytes which helps balance fluid levels and prevents dehydration related muscle cramps.

Which is better for hydration—Okra or Green Beans? (2)

Green Beans win out by a fraction—89.7% to 89.6%. These green vegies can be the basis for super side dishes filled with fiber and potassium.

Which is better for hydration—Peaches or Nectarines? (3)

It's a tie—Peaches and Nectarines are related both with 89% water. They are both also the source of beta carotene an antioxidant that helps protect the body from free radical damage, which can lead to chronic disease and other health problems.

Which is better for hydration—Corn or Yellow Bell Peppers? (4)

Yellow Bell Peppers are far ahead of corn when it comes to water content-92% verses 76%. Both deliver lots of nutrition. But 1/2 cup of Yellow Bell Peppers yields more than your minimum daily requirement of vitamin C.
