The lost and found will be in the lobby for the next two weeks. Afterwards, due to limited space, all items not claimed will be sent to Community Services or other organizations in the area.

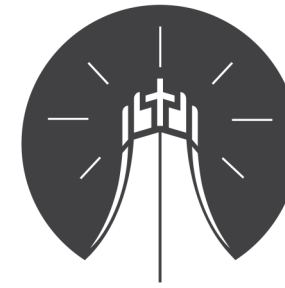
NCC Freshman/Sophomore Spiritual Retreat.
